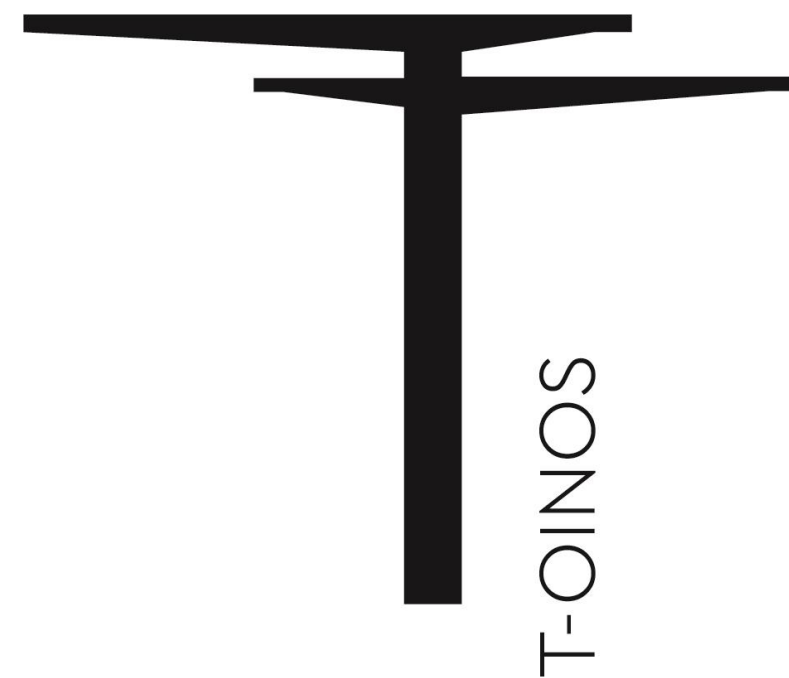

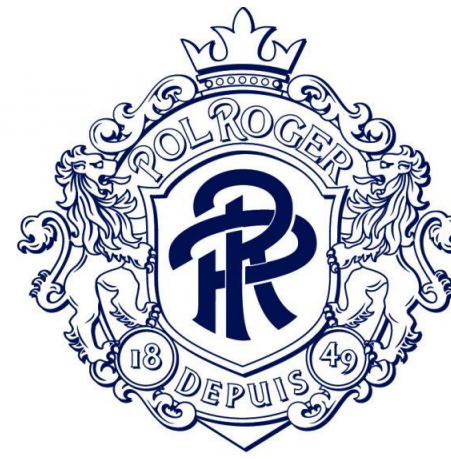


Approximately 20 years ago Alexandros Avatangelos and Gerard Margeon had a vision to create the best Greek wine with indigenous varieties in a unique setting, the island of Tinos. With a production that exceeds 20.000 bottles per year « Tiniaki Ampelones» wines have established the worldwide respect they deserve.

The initial planting of the vineyard took place in 2002, and production began six years later. Two years after the first bottling the wines of «Tiniaki Ampelones», were included in the wine lists of Alain Ducasse's famous restaurants which came to prove the uniqueness and the quality of the wines. T-oinos wines are derived from four vineyards of a total planted area of 13 hectares, on a sandy soil with granite bedrock, located on the outskirts of Falatados village, in Stegasta and Rassonas. The white grape varieties are Malagouzia and Asyrtiko, while the red ones are Mavrotragano and Avgoustiatis. The goal of everyone involved in T-oinos is to express the dynamics of each variety through the terroir in the best possible way giving great emphasis in their freshness, their mineral aromas and their durability.

CHAMPAGNE
POL ROGER

Pol Roger takes extreme pride in more than 160 years producing some of the world’s finest Champagne. Founded in 1849, Pol Roger is one of only a few Grande Marque Champagne houses that remains family owned and operated. Pol Roger owns close to 55% of the vineyards used for their Champagne production, a true rarity in this region of large firms. Their vineyard holdings equal to 92 hectares. Using strict guidelines, grapes are sourced mainly from 1er and Grand Cru vineyards that rate at an average of 95 points on the Échelle des Crus classification system. (In each vintage, the Échelle des Crus system.

Prior to final blending each lot is aged on its own, separated by village, vineyard, grower and grape variety. Once blended, each bottle of Champagne Pol Roger is aged and hand riddled in the 4.66 mile-long cellars under the Epernay château which are among the deepest (100 feet below ground) and coolest (48°F) cellars in champagne. Deep and cool cellars provide perfect conditions for the “prise de mousse” (the development of the Champagne in the bottle and the “finesse” of the “bead” or bubble) and for the long-ageing of their Champagne in bottle; in fact, all their Champagnes are aged longer than the legal requirement because doing so adds more complexity and fine bubbles in every bottle. In effect, each bottle of Cuvée Champagne is hand-made; 100% of Pol Roger Champagne is produced in its winery, nothing is outsourced. Controlled entirely from vineyard to bottle, Pol Roger Champagnes are the marriage of power and elegance.

“Pol Roger is the ‘gentlemen’s’ Champagne,” as Jean-Paul Kauffman wrote in Voyage en Champagne, adding, “It is not surprising, therefore, that Sir Winston Churchill, and even the British royal family, should have made it their favorite over the years. This refinement reflects a whole lifestyle. It is also a source of infinite pleasure. Pol Roger Champagne has a soul, created by the union of a family’s spirit and the character of a vineyard.”

La Closerie

Jérôme Prévost is a micro grower-producer based in the picture-perfect village of Gueux, on the edge of the Mountain de Reims or what the locals call la Petite Mountain. Here, in the northwest of Champagne, he grows a tiny quantity of remarkable, age-worthy Pinot Meunier from a single, two-hectare plot of forty-year-old vines. His wines have garnered a cult following across the globe and are sold strictly on allocation.

The Prévost story is a long one. Let's simplify and simply state that he inherited a vineyard from his grandmother and that it was his friend Anselme Selosse who encouraged and helped him to begin making wine from this parcel. His first vintage was 1998. Selosse let Prévost use his winery until 2003, after which Prévost began making the wine in the garage at the rear of his home in Gueux.

Prévost is an artist at heart: he was a painter as a young man and later turned to sculpting, photography and other passions that he prefers to keep to himself. His interest in art has led to several artists coming to visit his Estate and work with him in his vineyards. He has also organised wine and poetry celebrations with many great French poets: Valérie Rouzeau, James Sacré, Bernard Bretonnière and even the famed American poet John Giorno. He once said, *"I like words because they are like vines, planted in the soils of culture."*

Prévost's vines were planted in the '60s before what Prévost calls the *"...great industrial revolution in Champagne"*. This was prior to mechanisation, chemicals and clones becoming the norm. So, for this reason, the vines were planted with a good rootstock that was based on quality rather than yield. It's a rootstock that descends deeply but that takes far longer to grow above the ground; the opposite of what producers were looking for post-70s.

Prévost's initial idea was to produce one wine, each year, from one vineyard (les Béguines), one grape variety (Pinot Meunier), and one vintage. Sometimes Prévost also bottles a small amount of rosé. Over time, mainly thanks to the treacherous nature of his frost-prone terroir, this has evolved. The domaine devastating losses in 2017 prompted this grower to pivot from RM status (estate-only fruit) to NM (estate and purchased fruit) in order to make sustainable levels of wine. Prévost managed to secure some fruit from his neighbour's vines in Les Béguines along with some other parcels in Gueux, all on the same soils as the estate vines. The wine from these new sources is simply called La Closerie and carries a striking red ampersand motif on the label.

The wines of Jérôme Prévost are as complex and intriguing as the man himself. So how to sum them up in a few words? Tasting notes are useless as the wines shift, turn and evolve. Even when you open bottles of the same vintage (at different points in time) the wines are often very different. What we can say in general terms is that they are dry, vinous, aromatic, floral and spicy wines with huge energy, drive and longevity. They are textured yet very tightly wound. They are wildly complex, never boring, and they are great with food. They also benefit enormously from time (1-5 years) in the cellar.

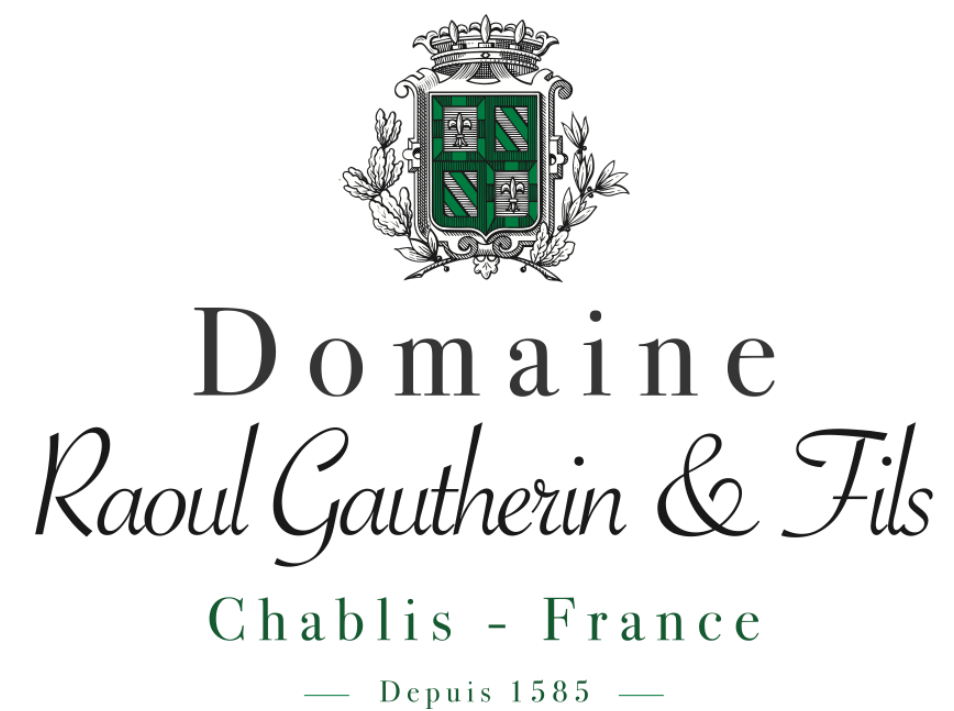
GUILLERAULT - FARGETTE
VIGNERONS A SANCERRE

In 1971, Jacques and Geneviève Guillerault created Domaine des Caves du Prieuré in an ancient (18th century) winery located in the village of Crézancy. Since 1995, their son Gilles has presided over the 19 hectare estate, joined by his brother-in-law Sébastien Fargette in 2001. At Guillerault – Fargette, their holdings are planted 75% to Sauvignon Blanc with the remainder planted to Pinot Noir. From a plot of Sauvignon Blanc vines comes the cuvée “Iota”. The name comes from the Greek letter “ι” and impersonates the mouthfeel after drinking the wine. After manual harvest, the wine is fermented in stainless steel vats and aged for 18 month on fermentation lees. The plot of vines, from which the “Epsilon” cuvée comes, were planted in 1972, on Kimmeridgian marl soils. This land represents a small part of the estate, which is why the term “ε”, which is used to designate small numbers, is being used to name this cuvée. The cuvée “Psi” is made from pinot noir grapes from different plots found in the villages of Reigny, Bué and Sancerre. Here the Greek letter Ψ is used, which with its three lines, represents the balance between fruit, freshness and finesse.

Gilles Guillerault and Sébastien Fargette are committed to sustainable viticulture. Natural grasses are grown between the rows and the soils are worked manually. No herbicides or pesticides are used. Each year, the harvest is brought in and carefully sorted on their sorting table before being pressed. The juice is allowed to settle by gravity before fermentation.

The Domaine Raoul Gautherin et fils is a family estate transmitted from father to son for many generations. The wines are elaborated in a traditional way, to let express the inimitable clay-limestone soil of Chablis. The vineyards are cultivated with rigor and passion in a reasoned and sustainable way producing from small Chablis to Grand Crus. The three Grand Crus are Vaudésirs, Grenouilles, and Les Clos. They are placed in front of the village, on the right side of the Serein river. The three Premier Crus are the Vaillons and Montmains "vieilles vignes" on the left side, and the Mont de Milieu on the right side. They are situated on the best expositions on the hillside. The Chablis Vieilles Vignes are the grapes that are chosen from their oldest vineyards, aged more than 35. After the vinification in tank, the wine is aged into barrels from 12 to 15 months. The Chablis express typicity of their terroir. They are fresh, balanced and have a strong minerality. The Petit Chablis "La terre de mon père" is a homage to Raoul Gautherin, father of Alain Gautherin and grandfather of Adrien Gautherin. It comes from their only vineyard of Petit Chablis, ideally situated right after their Chablis Premier Cru Vaillons. The vinification is a secret only known by Alain & Adrien.

ARNAUD ENTE



Arnaud married Marie-Odile Thévenot in 1991 and the following year started work in Meursault, farming vineyards rented from his father-in-law, vigneron Phillipe Thévenot. Arnaud and his wife work primarily on their own to craft an exquisite range of micro-production white Burgundies from Meursault and Puligny-Montrachet. During the 1990s Arnaud's wines attracted a lot of attention for their opulent style, due to his preference to pick late for maximum ripeness. Since 2000 the wines have displayed a more complex, naturally acidic style with enhanced minerality, which reflects the move to a programme of earlier picking. His wines are now amongst the very finest in the village. Domaine Arnaud Ente is one of the hottest wine properties in the region today and arguably Burgundy's brightest star. Stylistically Arnaud's wines lie somewhere between the rich, generous, hedonistic style of Dominique Lafon and the linear, precise, mineral, citrus character of Coche-Dury. Each vine is nurtured through every step of the yearly cycle, and each cru and village wine receives the exact same impeccable treatment; even the “entry-level” Aligoté and Bourgogne Blanc show the layered richness and complexity of a much more sophisticated appellation.

BERNARD-BONIN

Since 1998, Domaine Bernard-Bonin has been run impeccably by Nicolas Bernard and Véronique Bonin, a daughter of the well-known Michelot family.

The majority of the vines at Domaine Bernard-Bonin are in Meursault. The remaining in Puligny-Montrachet. In Meursault there are various village appellation vineyards such as Clos du Crouin, Les Tillets and Limozin. On premier cru level they have Genevrières and Charmes-Dessus in Meursault and La Garenne and Les Folatières in Puligny-Montrachet.

The estate follows time-honored winegrowing traditions : hand-harvesting, respecting the phases of the moon and employing minimal intervention in the cellar. Each wine expresses a personality derived from its terroir, its character fashioned by the climatic variances of the year, with the premier cru vineyards harvested last.

Their philosophy is to be as close to natural farming as possible. The “lute raisonnee” (the reasoned struggle) in combination with organic wine growing. They use some sulphur., but no copper because of its long-term effects in the soil health.

J.-F. COCHE-DURY

One need only speak of Meursault to evoke a myriad of questions regarding the village's resident icon, Jean-François Coche. He began working in the family vineyards alongside his father, Georges, at the age of fourteen, becoming the third generation of Coches to tend these vines. His marriage to Odile Dury in 1975 added to the family holdings, which lead to the formation of Domaine Coche-Dury. Since then, the enigmatic, modest, Jean-François has only reluctantly accepted the celebrity status of his wines. When asked, he would be most likely say that it is rigor, constant vigilance, and adherence to old-school tradition that makes the wines so special.. Today, his son, Raphaël, has taken the reins with his wife, Charline, and the two continue the family tradition with great reverence. The Coches farm almost nine hectares of vineyards on minuscule parcels over six communes: Meursault, Puligny-Montrachet, Auxey-Duresses, Monthelie, and Volnay. Though they are best known for their Chardonnay, they also bottle six exquisite Pinot Noirs. Coche believes strongly that the white wines of Burgundy should have nerve, and his are never among the ripest or highest in alcohol of his colleagues. It is their vibrant acidity, often hidden in the opulence that helps them to age so successfully and predictably. Though their bottlings are extremely limited, any chance to taste the wines of Coche-Dury promises a rare glimpse into some of the greatest vineyard management and winemaking in the world.

— *Benoit Ente* —



By succession from his grandfather Camille David, Benoit Ente has a small domaine (6 hectares in total) including two Premiers Crus: Folatières “En la Richarde” and “Clos de la Truffière”, two Villages: Puligny-Montrachet and Chassagne-Montrachet, and two Regionals: Bourgogne Chardonnay and Bourgogne Aligoté.

A part of Benoit Ente’s vineyards were planted by his grandfather in the 1950s, which has enabled Benoit to benefit from grapes from old vines. Some vineyards are younger and were planted by Benoit himself in the 1990s and 2000’s. Benoit Ente has also made heavy investments in his cellars that have helped him gain extra quality and precision for vinification and élevage.

Benoit believes in sustainable grape growing, as he maintains his soils with no usage of chemical weed killers or fertilizers.

The harvest date is determined with accuracy and the picking of the grapes is done by hand exclusively, Benoit and his brother Arnaud are famous in Burgundy for an early start when it comes to harvest. It is simply because first, their grapes are ripe and second, they also want to preserve the acidity.

Benoit is at the moment, along with his brother Arnaud, the best white winemaker in the area. They both defy what it is possible to imagine in terms of purity, precision and terroir expression. Benoit’s wines strike a balance of power, richness of fruit, bright mouth-watering acidity, extract, length, complexity, purity and age ability.

DOMAINE de MONTILLE

Domaine de Montille is one of the most iconic producers in Burgundy with a very long and fascinating story that dates back to 1730. Although the name de Montille is synonymous with the village of Volnay, where the family's house remains still, this historic estate has spread out to a total of 25 hectares and is now one of the largest estates in the Cote d'Or region. The 1995 the production became organic and in 2005 it became biodynamic focusing on whole bunch fermentation giving the wines of de Montille a distinctive taste and style.

GUY AMIOT ET FILS

GRANDS VINS DE BOURGOGNE DEPUIS 1920

Domaine Amiot was founded in Chassagne-Montrachet in 1920 by Arsene Amiot when he acquired select parcels of vines or “climats” in Chassagne including Vergers, Caillerets, Clos St. Jean and in what is today Le Montrachet. Under Aresene, Domaine Amiot became one of the first domaines in Burgundy to bottle their own production.

In the 1930’s the domaine passed to Aresene’s son, Pierre, who continued to add top sites such as Champsgains, Macherelles, Maltroie and their tiny parcel in Puligny, Les Demoiselles.

Pierre’s son, Guy, took the reins in 1985 and solidified the reputation of the domaine for producing wines of exceptional quality from an impressive array of top vineyard sites.

Guy’s son Thierry took over the winemaking in 2003 and continues the tradition of expressing the unique character of each vineyard site while constantly seeking to improve the quality of the wines while his brother Fabrice, makes sure that the wines are being promoted worldwide!

Perched in the high hills of Blagny above Meursault and Puligny Montrachet, Comtesse de Cherisey is a steadfast domaine with a history of pure and intensely mineral whites that continue to reveal some of the best kept secrets of the Cote d’Or. Once tended to by the Cistercian monks of Mezieres in the 14th century, Hélène Martelet-de-Chérisey and Laurent Martelet are the current vigneron working rigorously to preserve the heritage and tradition of this ancient terroir.

The vineyards are hand-harvested from across 9 hectares, including a small collection of limestone-laden premier cru sites with vines averaging over 60 years of age.

From the rich and layered power of their La Genelotte monopole of Meursault-Blagny, to racy expressions of the Puligny Montrachet Premier Cru La Garenne, the wondrous whites of Comtesse de Cherisey reveal a true sense of purity and value.

Fabien Duperray knows great wine, and has a good idea how to make it too. In 2007 he purchased ancient Gamay vineyards in Fleurie and Moulin-à-Vent (some over 140 years), and Chardonnay parcels in a range of Côte Maconnais appellations in 2014. Farming is biodynamic, yields are very low, and his main focus is making the most balanced, age-worthy wines possible.

Fabien is a force-of-nature and very confident in his methods, although rather than put his own name on the label he called his domaine 'Jules Desjournays' – Jules after the late, great Beaujolais vigneron Jules Chauvet, and Desjournays "because I liked how it sounded next to Jules". Recent experiments have led to the patenting of 200L and 500L glass fermenters that he and friend Arnaud Ente are excited about using.

Reds come from three crus, Chénas, Fleurie and Moulin-à-Vent. Older vintages were raised for 24 months in barrel, but Fabien decided that he wanted "more terroir and less François Frères" in the wines, so he has phased out oak in favour of steel and glass. Whites hail from Macon-Verzé, St-Veran and three of the Pouillys (Loché, Vinzelles and Fuissé) and are all made in tank with the exception of the Pouilly-Fuissé and Pouilly-Fuissé 'Vignes Blanches', which are both vinified using what Fabien calls "the Coche method".

These wines are built with the harmony and quality to age for the long-term, but – like the top quality red and white Burgundies that they call to mind – there is a drinkability to them that makes it difficult to resist pulling their corks immediately. This is a domaine which, stylistically and qualitatively, is already in the top echelon of Beaujolais and Côte Maconnais producers.

DOMAINE DE LA JANASSE



Domaine de la Janasse is a Châteauneuf-du-Pape producer owned and operated by the Sabon family. It was founded in 1967 by Aimé Sabon when he took over the vineyards of his father, who had been selling fruit to a wine cooperative. The winery makes a number of wines including red and white Côtes du Rhône, and a number of IGP wines, but the flagship wines have always been the Châteauneuf-du-Pape reds. The winery makes three distinct expressions: Domaine de la Janasse Tradition, Chaupin and Vieilles Vignes. It also makes a white version of Tradition and a second white wine called Prestige. Over the last quarter-century, Domaine de la Janasse has become one of the most highly-regarded estates in Châteauneuf-du-Pape. The reds from Janasse are frequently considered to be among the best in the region whether it is their pleasingly complex Côtes-du-Rhone and Côtes-du-Rhône Villages or their three bottlings of Châteauneuf-du-Pape.

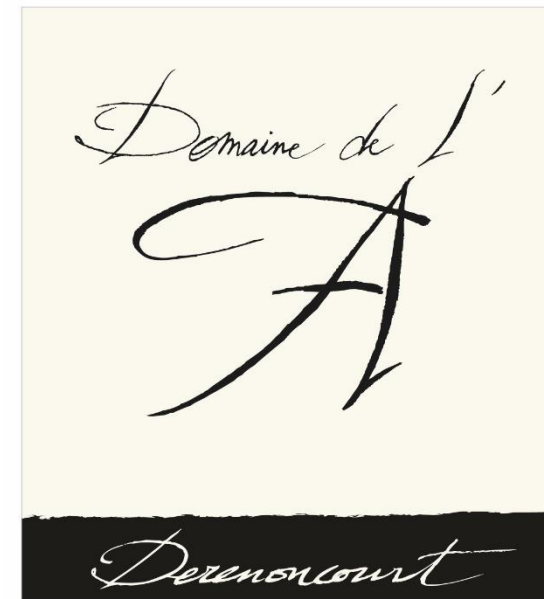


Apart of producing some of the finest rose wines anyone can find in Provence, Commanderie de Peyrassol is followed by a long and important history like very few others in France. The vineyards lay in an altitude between 220 m to 350 m above sea level in a land of 900 hectares. Thirteen different varieties are planted in Peyrassol. Red grape varieties such as Cinsault, Grenache, Tibouren, Mourverde, Syrah, and Cabernet Sauvignon and white grape varieties such as Semillon and Ugni-blanc.

Although the estate produces red and white wines, the stars of the Chateau are its rose wines. The grapes are 100% own production, mainly from old vines, and the end result offers one of the best expressions of the terroir of Provence. Since 2023 the production is organically certified

Domaine de l'A is Stéphane and Christine Derenoncourt's brilliant home estate in Castillon, just outside St. Emilion.

Stéphane is one of Bordeaux's top consultant oenologists, and of global renown. He is best known for producing the wines at a string of superstar properties including Domaine de Chevalier, Clos Fourtet, Clos de l'Oratoire and Chateaux Pavie-Macquin, Canon-la-Gaffelière, Smith Haut Lafitte, Les Carmes Haut-Brion, Prieuré-Lichine and Beauséjour Duffau-Lagarrosse. Stéphane and Christine purchased 2.5 hectares in the commune of Sainte-Colombe, Côtes de Castillon in 1999. Today they have 11 hectares, divided among various parcels, the majority on a south-facing slope with tuffeau limestone soil (to which Stéphane attributes his wine's floral aroma). The average age of the Merlot (70%) and Cabernet Franc (30%) vines is 55 years old. The domaine is organic but (for the time being) uncertified. Yields are tiny: 28 hectolitres/hectare in a generous vintage. Owing to its scale, undulating vineyards and the ethereal character of its wines, the domaine has a distinctly Burgundian vibe. This one of those estates where the quality massively outperforms the expected level of the appellation, thanks to some special terroir, and the genius of the winemaker.

ODDERO



Poderi e Cantine Oddero is one of the most historic estates in Barolo, with winemaking roots dating back to the late 18th century. The tradition of bottling wines under the Oddero name began in 1878, a pioneering move by Giacomo Oddero that laid the foundation for a legacy now upheld by the seventh generation.

Located in Santa Maria di La Morra, the estate spans approximately 35 hectares, of which 16.5 are planted with Nebbiolo for Barolo and Barbaresco. Oddero's vineyards include prestigious crus such as Brunate, Bussia Vigna Mondoca, Rocche di Castiglione, Villero, Vignarionda, and Gallina—recognized among the region's finest.

The winery practices certified organic viticulture and avoids chemical herbicides, choosing mechanical methods instead.

Winemaking combines tradition and sustainability: aging takes place in large oak barrels from Austria, France, and Slovenia, and the modern cellar, built in 2015, is designed with solar-powered energy efficiency.

Today, Maria Cristina Oddero, her son Pietro, and niece Isabella lead the estate, continuing a legacy of quality and authenticity rooted in the Langhe hills.

In 1894, Domizio Cavazza, headmaster of the Royal Oenological School of Alba and owner of Barbaresco Castle and the adjoining farm, founded the “Cantine Sociali di Barbaresco” for the “production of luxury and table wines”. Gathering nine farmers and landowners around him, he began to make wine in the Castle cellars and named the wine after the village itself.

That the Nebbiolo cultivated in Barbaresco had its own distinct character was a well-known fact, but Cavazza was the first to recognize this distinctiveness on the label, with the plan to boost the reputation of the product and of the municipality, following in the footsteps of Barolo, which was just beginning to be established.

This makes 1894 the unofficial year of birth of Barbaresco wine.

Cavazza died in 1913 and then, with the advent of fascism, the cooperative winery was closed in the 1920s.

Don Fiorino Marengo arrived in Barbaresco immediately after the Second World War. A modern-day Saint Francis, the young priest threw himself headlong into a myriad of activities, never for a moment neglecting his ministry. Inspired by the unforgettable example of Domizio Cavazza, Don Fiorino became convinced that the associative experience could be repeated again to seek the emancipation of the country people from extreme poverty and deep-rooted individualism. So in 1958, he brought together nineteen farmers and founded Produttori del Barbaresco “to qualify and guarantee Barbaresco”.

The priest received valuable help from a leading local figure, the pharmacist of Neive. Dr. Maffei was held in the highest regard in the area, he owned several vineyards and was seeking a better yield for his land. The contribution of Riccardo Cravanzola and Lorenzo Viglino, later to become the first two presidents of the cooperative, was also decisive. And then of course there was the patient and tireless work of Celestino Vacca, “the secretary”

Substantial profits began to flow in at the end of the 1980s and the Produttori del Barbaresco label became increasingly prestigious. The members, now more than 50, had finally become “winegrowers”, known and appreciated the world over. From the 1990s, the doors of the international market opened wide: the US, Japan, Scandinavia and the United Kingdom competed for a label that had become an international emblem of typicality and uncompromising quality.

Today, Produttori del Barbaresco is regarded as one of the most prestigious wineries in the area and is an example for cooperatives all over the world.

The vineyards of the South Tyrolean winegrowers' cooperative Nals Margreid extend over fourteen areas from Nals in the north, situated between Bolzano and Merano, to Margreid in the southern part of the lowlands. Thus, the cooperative in the Adige Valley, which was formed from the union of the Nals Winery (founded in 1932) and Margreid-Entiklar (founded in 1954) and has 137 members, has a considerable variety of different terroirs and growing areas.

Thanks to the professional competence of the creative and very precisely working cellar master Harald Schraffl, the style of the wines has become more concise from year to year. The fact that the winegrowers' cooperative has quickly caught up with the Bolzano Wine Tip is also due to the cellar building, which has been renovated according to functional and oenological criteria and ideally combines the historical stock with the high demands of modern wine pressing.

The vines of the wine-growers, which cover 165 hectares, are rooted on soil that is particularly suitable for them. These are usually calcareous debris cones, sandy river alluvial soils and glacial deposits as moraine scree.

The vineyards are situated at an altitude of 200 to 900 metres, protected by the Alpine arc in the north and spoiled by almost Mediterranean influences from the south. Nature creates around 300 days of sunshine a year here and ensures great differences in temperature between day and night.

Using the force of gravity and avoiding detours, drops (mostly white) of the most important South Tyrolean wine types, divided into the "Classic" and "Selection" lines, are prepared in the cellars as carefully as possible. The wines made in Nals from Pinot Blanc and Pinot Gris, Chardonnay and Cabernet have a clear structure, are acidic, concentrated and powerful. They also show distinct mineral traces. The most common grape variety in South Tyrol, Vernatsch, as well as Lagrein, Pinot Noir and Merlot are used as raw materials for the red wines.

Castello dei Rampolla was founded in 1956, however the history of its owners, the Napoli Rampolla family, dates back on this site to 1739. The estate is based in the hilltop town of Panzano, and is famed for the Conca d'Oro (golden basin) – an outstanding natural amphitheatre composed of the village's hillsides, neighbouring Fontodi. It was under the stewardship of Alceo di Napoli Rampolla in the second half of the twentieth century that Castello dei Rampolla began to make a name for itself. Having been inspired by Mario Incisa della Rocchetta – the legendary creator of Sassicaia – Alceo decided to attempt his own Bordeaux style wine with Cabernet Sauvignon. He recruited the help of world famous consultant oenologist Giacomo Tachis and soon enough Castello dei Rampolla's ability to incarnate Bordeaux blends in Tuscany pushed the estate into the spotlight. Their wine, Sammarco, became a superstar in the Castello dei Rampolla collection, despite criticism from Chianti Classico traditionalists in the region.

Alceo passed away in 1991 so the estate passed onto his children, Luca and Maurizia di Napoli. The siblings have continued their father's revolutionary work, transforming the estate with biodynamic farming practices, removal of chemical treatments in the vines as well as manual harvests. Alceo's children have also dedicated a wine in his honour – named 'd'Aleco'. The grapes come from a single vineyard at an altitude of 1,140ft producing a wine which has eclipsed the Sammarco. Production at Castello dei Rampolla remains small, ranging from 8,000 to 25,000 bottles per year depending on the vintage. However, for those lucky enough to sample them, the Castello dei Rampolla wines live up to their bold reputation and are lauded for their graceful ageing abilities.

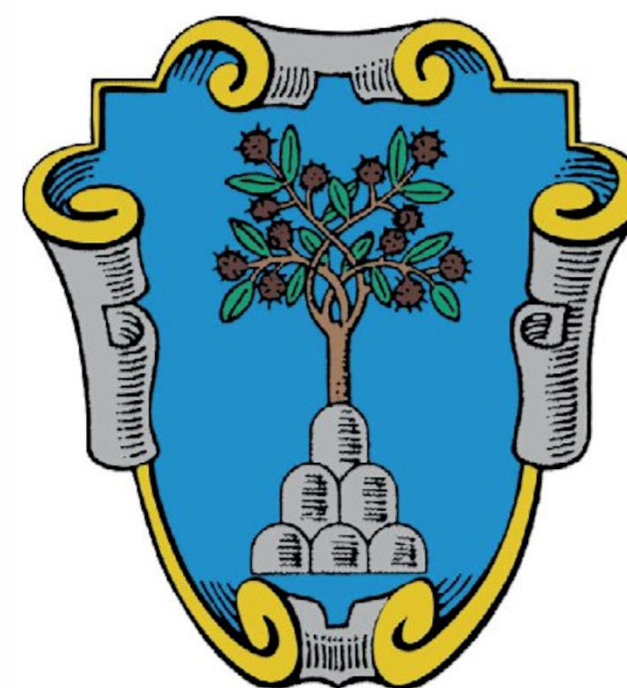




Fontodi has belonged to the Manetti family since 1968. The family has been associated for centuries with another activity typical of the Chianti region, the production of its famous “terrecotte” tiles. And it is in the name of this strong link with the territory and a great passion for quality that the estate has moved successfully towards an ever more attentive cultivation of the vineyards and a more profound knowledge of the potential of Sangiovese in the zone of Panzano. Fontodi is located in the heart of Chianti Classico precisely in the valley which lies south of the town of Panzano and is called the “Conca d’Oro” (the golden shell) because of its amphitheatre shape. A genuine and characteristic “Terroir”, famous for centuries for its tradition of quality wine cultivation, thanks to a unique combination of high altitude, calcareous schist soil, lots of light, and a fantastic micro-climate – warm and dry with a marked difference in day and night-time temperatures Fontodi is a certified organic estate which extends over 130 hectares of which about 70 are planted with vines. The type of agriculture practised is inspired by the principles of respect of nature and sustainability. Not only are no chemical products used but there is an effort to maximize the internal resources of the estate, thereby reducing the need for any external input. Respecting the environment means wines that are better, purer, and a truer expression of the grape and the territory. The process of vinification and ageing in wood takes place in the modern cellar, built on descending levels to take advantage of gravity, guaranteeing the most respect possible for the natural integrity of the grape, in order to exalt the character and elegance of the wines.

IL MARRONETO

Il Marroneto is one of the older estates in Montalcino having been established in 1974 by Giuseppe Mori. Mori's sons Alessandro and Andrea, busy with their occupations as lawyers – having followed their father's footsteps – showed great interest in winemaking. In 1980, the first vintage was made by the brothers' hands in two small rooms at Il Marroneto. The estate's 5.8 hectares have been planted in stages: The first 10% in 1975, an additional 10% in 1977, and the rest in the winter between 1982-1983. Elevation of the vineyard sits at 400 meters above sea level, and soils are an intricate mix of mostly sand large stone of limestone and galestro. Vines are planted with ample spacing in mind so that Sangiovese thrives in nutrient-rich topsoil that encourages good rooting. Here in the north, cooler weather turns out more distinctive Brunellos of precision, elegance and aromatics. Creating some of the most elegant and long-lived Brunellos in the appellation, Alessandro Mori leans strictly to the traditionalist canon of Brunello producers. Mori's practice of minimal intervention in the vineyard, eschewing the use of chemicals, allowing only native yeast ferments, and traditional cask ageing in the cellar are principles of his philosophy that underscore his mission to create wines "derived strictly from nature."

Since VON WINNING Winery was founded in 1849, unique wines reflecting vineyards in Ruppertsberg, Deidesheim, and Forst have been produced in their historic cellar.

In 1907, Leopold von Winning, son-in-law of Dr. Andreas Deinhard, dedicated his life to creating top quality wines with respect to the outstanding vineyards in which he was allowed to work. As a founding member of the VDP he introduced his beliefs into the philosophy of this renowned association. Today, the young and ambitious team around Stephan Attmann deliberately uphold this visionary's tradition.

Intensive and sustainable work in the vineyards enables to harvest highly aromatic and healthy grapes. This valuable fruit is vinified with a lot of patience and untreated in VW historic cellar. Musts are fermented relatively turbid and without artificial cooling in different size oak barrels using their indigenous yeasts. This way they preserve the precious phenolic compounds, which shape the aroma and bestow a deep and complex structure upon Von Winnings' wines. Subsequently, the wines are moved only one time on their way into the bottle. This way, grapes from significant vineyard sites become special wines, which express the house's unique style.

César Marquez Perez has deep roots in Bierzo. His family founded the Castro Ventosa winery in 1752 and they still own it today. Thanks to that long history, he has access to many of the top sites in the region. He has grown up in the vines and wineries in Bierzo and has learned from his elders, including his uncle Raul Perez. And now he has his own project. He launched his solo project in 2015 with 4 wines. Today he makes 7 wines from 6 HA of 80 to 120 year old vines.

He is a part of the new wave of Spanish vignerons who have a knowledge of the greater world of wine and also a respect for and connection to the land around him. He is finding old vines in unique sites and vinifying them separately to showcase the ability of Mencía to transmit terroir. He is structuring his lineup of wines in Burgundian fashion - appellation wine, village wine, single vineyard wines. He is farming organically. He is using partial whole cluster, reductive winemaking and low sulfur. He is making wines that are not just great for Bierzo or Spain, but that stand along the best wines from any region or country.

Dominio del Águila

Dominio del Águila is a family winery based in La Aguilera, a small village in Ribera del Duero, and run by a couple formed by Jorge Monzón and Isabel Roderó, vigneron and architect respectively. Jorge comes from a family of many generations of vignerons. His studies were based in 'Soil, viticulture and oenology' at the Universities of Bordeaux and Burgundy. He worked with prestigious wineries such as Domaine De La Romanée-Conti for more than two years. He has also worked in Spain in the Vega Sicilia Group for a year and as technical director of Bodegas Arzuaga-Navarro for nine years. Since 2013 he works full time in Dominio del Águila. The winery's main brand is 'Dominio del Águila'. It is a 'vino reserva' with more than 30 months ageing in French oak barrels. Also they produce a claret and a red wine aged for about 15 months, called 'Picaro del Águila'. These wines are the basis of their work, but they also have a range of other wines of great personality, such as 'Canta la Perdiz', a 'Gran reserva' that ages more than 40 months in oak barrels

The Standish Wine Company

The Standish Wine company was founded in 1999 by Dan Standish. He started at that time with a small, family-owned plot of almost hundred-year-old Shiraz vines in the heart of the Barossa Valley, in the sub-region of Vine Vale. He is part of the sixth generation of immigrants who settled here in 1848. In his career, Dan Standish gained experience not only in his home country, but also in California, Spain and France. He is passionate about the great wines of the Rhône Valley.

His wines all reflect outstanding personalities. They stand out for their complexity, concentration and elegance, and never for excessive opulence or heaviness, as a first glance might have you believe. They all come from authentic roots, literally meaning non-grafted vines, as this region was fortunately spared from the global phylloxera plague. The oldest ones, over a hundred years old, are used for Standish and Relic. The vineyards are all located in the Barossa Valley except for those for the Borne Bollene, which come from the Eden Valley, West of Barossa.

Dan Standish is an advocate of "hands-off and natural winemaking" – a more natural and traditional vinification technique involving little or no intervention. The grapes are crushed by foot and spontaneously fermented with their own yeasts in open wooden fermentation casks. Old basket presses are used to apply a gentle press. The maturation is carried out in used French oak barrels.

Dan Standish is undoubtedly one of the most exceptionally gifted winemakers in Australia, with the ability to elicit a whole universe of aromas from some of the oldest vines on our planet.

Racines is a collaboration between two classic houses from France, led by vigneron Étienne de Montille and Brian Sieve of Burgundy and Rodolphe Péters of Champagne. The team came together to join their individual experiences in hand-crafting wines of purity and transparency to create a range of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from the cool climate of the Sta. Rita Hills in California.

The project is the first venture for Étienne and Rodolphe beyond France and represents the coming together of all that is wonderful about Burgundy, Champagne and California.

These wines confirm something many have long suspected: that if you are looking to make terroir driven, elegant, balanced wines in the new world, then Sta. Rita Hills is the place.

Established in 2002, Tabalí is a pioneer and iconic winery situated in Limari, in one of the northernmost vineyard regions of Chile. They were one of the first wineries to settle in Limari and their wines faithfully reflect their place of origin in which climate and soils play a fundamental role, and bring out the potential of each of their vineyards.

Tabali is considered by many as the best winery in Chile and it has faced international recognition. In 2021, CEO and Chief Winemaker, Felipe Müller was voted as best winemaker of the country. This was accompanied by the award for Best Icon Wine for the 2019 Roca Madre - Malbec and the 2021 Talinay Chardonnay which was voted best Chardonnay of Chile.

The historical origin of the Levi's family is from the village of "Fraciscio di Campodolcino" in the valley of "Spluga" (close to the Swiss border) where they operated as distillers since the 17th century.

For more than two centuries these distillers migrated to the Piemonte region when it was grape vintage time. they moved there with a few mobile alembics and distilled locally, producing high quality grappa, mainly from Barolo and Barbaresco (Nebbiolo) marcs.

From mid 19th century some of these distillers decided to remain in the area where large wine makers were present and installed some important distilleries, not only in Piemonte but also in Lombardia and Veneto.

At "Fraciscio di Campodolcino" the old Levi' family house still exist, called "Casadegli Angeli" (Angel's house) as all family head had the Angelo name.

Levi Serafino married Balbo Teresina and they had two children: Lidia and Romano. In 1920 Serafino decided to move to Neive as territory with great wines and where high quality marc was available in large quantity.

In 1924, in Neive, he founded his distillery "a fuoco diretto" (at open flame).

Unfortunately Serafino died very young in 1937 and left two young children Romano (1928) and Lidia (1926) and his wife, Teresina, which kept on working in the distillery. But Teresina died in 1945 from one of the few bombs that was launched against the town of Neive during the war.

At that time Romano was only 17 years old and he was a student at Alba. He decided to stop studying and, with the assistance of his sister Lidia, began to work in the distillery, from which he never moved away, till his death on May, 1st, 2008.

All labels currently applied to the bottles are a reproduction of the original hand drawings of Romano Levi dated from 1962-1963.
